

Lesson 3 — Partial Simulation

Session 3 of 8 | Duration: 60 min | Artifact: 90-sec walkthrough of the recovery plan beat

Purpose

Drill the recovery plan beat — the language-densest segment, where most B1 speakers default to vague verbs and open-ended commitments.

Phases

Time	Phase	Trainer does
0:00–0:05	Warm-up	Revisit the five-beat structure on screen. Show the language bank from L2.
0:05–0:20	Brief the segment	Hand out the L4 scenario (preview below). Today managers do only the recovery plan beat — 90 seconds.
0:20–0:35	Planning	Each manager notes their 2–3 recovery actions. Each action must be paired with a specific time AND a named person or team. No "as soon as possible". No "we'll handle it".
0:35–0:55	Performance	Each manager records a 90-sec recovery plan beat for the same scenario.
0:55–1:00	Close	One observation on language: where the time+person pairing held; where it broke. Save recordings.

Scripted teacher language

"You're not doing the full briefing today. Only the recovery plan. 90 seconds."

"Every action gets a time AND a person. Never just one. 'We'll dispatch a replacement' is not enough — pair it with 'by 11:00' and 'handled by Khalid in Dammam dispatch'."

"Language bank stays visible. Use the phrases."

Scenario — recovery plan beat only

Scenario preview: A three-truck cement haul from Riyadh to a megaproject site in NEOM. Two of the three trucks were cleared at the Highway 50 inspection checkpoint. The third was flagged for an axle-weight discrepancy — overloaded by 1.8 tonnes — and is now held at the checkpoint. The customer (the megaproject's logistics coordinator) was expecting all three trucks on site by 16:00 today for tomorrow's concrete pour. The third truck must be partially offloaded and re-weighed at the nearest depot, which is 90 minutes away. Realistic new ETA for the third truck: 20:00.

The segment: Walk through the recovery plan beat only. 90 seconds. Name 2–3 specific actions. Pair each with a time and a named person or team. State the committed quantity.

Between-session work

No homework. The full L4 scenario will be handed out next session for fresh reading.
